**INFORMATION:** Human CD117 (c-kit) is a transmembrane protein with receptor tyrosine kinase capacity and serves as the receptor for steel factor (SLF). CD117 is expressed on almost all hematopoietic progenitor cells and receptor/ligand interaction is crucial for development of hematopoietic stem cells. Antibody 57A5 recognizes the CD117 molecule of about 150 kd.

**STORAGE CONDITIONS:** *Store at 2 - 5<sup>o</sup>C*. Freeze/Thawing is not recommended.

**PRODUCT STABILITY:** Product should retain activity for at least 12 months after shipping date when stored as recommended. Ship Date:

**BUFFER:** 50 mM Sodium Phosphate pH 7.5, 100 mM Potassium Chloride, 150mM NaCl, 5% Glycerol, 0.2% BSA, 0.04% NaN<sub>3</sub> (as a preservative).

**PRODUCTION:** Antibody from (low FBS containing) tissue culture supernatant was Protein A purified to >95% mouse immunoglobulin by SDS-PAGE (<1% bovine immunoglobulin), and reacted with NHS-Biotin. Unconjugated Biotin was removed from conjugate using a desalting column.

**PERFORMANCE:** Five x 10<sup>5</sup> cultured **HEL** cells were washed and pre incubated 10 minutes with 20 µl human IgG at 250 mg/ml (to block non specific binding) after which they were incubated 45 minutes on ice with 80 µl of anti-CD117/Biotin at 10 µg/ml. Cells were washed twice and incubated with 20 reagent Streptavidin/R-Phycoerythrin (Catalog #253-050), after which they were washed three times, fixed and analyzed by FACS. Cells stained positive with a mean shift of 1.41 log<sub>10</sub> fluorescent units when compared to a Mouse IgG1 negative control (Catalog #278-030). Binding was blocked when cells were pre incubated 10 minutes with 20 µl of 0.5 mg/ml anti-CD117 antibody (Catalog #338-020).
